Relating to Second Day of Out-of-Country Voting**

Due to the high turnout for voting in the Egyptian Embassy in Kuwait and the heavy presence of Egyptians in the streets surrounding the embassy, the mobile base station tower covering the area of the Egyptian embassy became out of service as a result of the heavy stress on communications. Thus the e-readers became too slow to work leading to delaying the voting process which is done through it.

The general committee for Egyptians out-of-country has taken necessary measures in coordination with the Egyptian ambassador to Kuwait and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to restore the network performance by requiring vehicles to strengthen the network in the perimeter of the Egyptian Embassy in Kuwait.

The Committee calls on Egyptians surrounding the embassy to reduce the use of mobile phones as much as possible, noting that the embassy continues to work until the completion of all the voters who are in scope.
