Judge Dr./ Abdul Aziz Salman announced that the Committee has yesterday completed its examination of the issue of energy-saving light bulbs that some popular campaigns had distributed.

The Committee ended up in custody of papers as it was not proved that the candidate is the one who ordered the distribution of said light bulbs, and that his official campaign denied any relationship with this issue. The committee did not find any evidence confirming that the candidate or his official campaign are the ones who had distributed them, and also the candidate's agent investigated the matter and reached to those in charge of the distribution and requested that they stop immediately and distribution did stop.

The candidate emphasized his strong interest in compliance with the law that he cannot exceed its limits, he accordingly stopped the distribution at once, hence the Committee stands at this point.

The Committee also received many delegations of international observers, including:

The Committee ensured that all the observation requirements had been met and provided them with all the information and responded to all questions submitted by each delegation.

Today committee will meet with Elections Commissions of Mexico, Jordan, India and Nigeria.
