

Media Release no. (43) On 26 /05 /2014

Judge Dr./ Abdul Aziz Salman, Secretary General of the Presidential Elections Committee, stated that the electoral process has started at 9:00 a.m. in about 90% of the polling stations on a regular basis and a few number of them have started a bit late for reasons mostly due to the remoteness of the electoral premises, some judges' lack of knowledge of these premises and finally due to delay of some civil servants to access the polling stations. By 10:15 a.m. the work within the polling station has became in order of 100%.

The Committee received a call from the General the Assistant of Interior Minister for Public Safety Affairs that police had found the missing papers belonging to the Assiut district no. 49 polling station and were confiscated to be sent to the Presidential Elections Committee to be discarded.

The Committee had received a large number of complaints from representatives of candidates and citizens about large numbers of voters waiting in queue in front of some polling stations. In return the Committee immediately sent a number of reserve judges to assist the heads of the polling stations. There were other complaints concerning out of governorates voters who did not find themselves in the lists of the polling stations that they had applied to transfer to. The Committee has found that some of the complaints were real while others were not.

The Presidential Elections Committee had replaced four judges. Two because of raised suspicions against them and their influencing of voters; while the other two were replaced due to their exhaustion because of the heavy work load and pressure.

The Committee declares that tomorrow voting in polling stations shall extend till 10:00 p.m. depending on the circumstances of each polling station and the presence of voters in the electoral premises.
