The Secretary General announced that within the framework of the Committee's follow-up on both judges and the electoral process, yesterday in the evening and after the termination of the voting process while Judge/ Mohamed Khairy was on his way to the headquarters of the District Committee to hand over the papers of the electoral process after counting was completed, and exactly at mid-night, was subjected to an attack from four armed persons and the police force accompanying his Excellency resisted and managed to deal with them. This incident has resulted in an gunshot wound in the leg, however he insisted on going to the District Committee headquarters to deliver the papers of the electoral process in spite of the bleeding and the threat it posed on his life. After he had delivered papers to the head of the District Committee, he was transferred to the Dar Al Fouad Hospital to extract the bullet from his leg, and remains in the hospital until now.

Once the Presidential Elections committee became aware of the incident, it dispatched three judge members of the Secretariat of the Committee to check on his condition within half an hour of his Excellency's arrival at the hospital. The Committee was reassured of his condition, and in the morning, the head of the Committee and the Secretary-General telephoned His Excellency to reassure his health.

Accordingly, the Committee owes thanks and gratitude to this honourable judge for his strong desire to fully accomplish his duty towards his country putting the interests of the country over his own, as such delay may have exposed his life to danger due to the bleeding. This is not strange to the judges of Egypt who sacrifice all that is precious for Egypt.
